History of Tipp City

In 1840, John Clark planted the seed that would develop into Tippecanoe. Situated on the Miami-Erie Canal at what is now State Route 571, the town was established to take advantage of the traffic on the canal. Clark named his new town "Tippecanoe" to express his admiration for Presidential candidate William Henry Harrison, also known as "Old Tippecanoe." Harrison was running for President under the campaign slogan "Tippecanoe and Tyler, too." In 1938, the town's name was shorted to Tipp City.

Preserving our rich architectural legacy is important to the residents of Tipp City. Our quaint downtown offers a variety of shops and restaurants, many located in the 90 historical buildings and landmarks that add to the charm of the community. The Tippecanoe Historic District, established in 1981, preserves and protects our downtown historical properties by including them in the National Register of Historic Places.
